2. Take Exit 31B to Route 11 North (toward Miramichi)
3. Take Exit 7 (just after the river)
4. At the stop sign, turn left; go over the highway.
5. At the next stop sign, turn left onto Shediac River Rd
6. Follow the large right turn, travel about 0.5 km to the first street on the left (Aurel Poirier Dr.)
7. Go to very end of the road; turn left onto Ch. Petite Pre
8. Drive to the very end of road to the last house.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

1. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the AAC rules that govern this trial and FAME's policies. These can be viewed at <http://www.aac.ca/> and <http://www.famemoncton.ca>.
2. The trial is open to all dogs over 1-1/2 years except bitches in heat, dogs suffering from injuries or dogs showing signs of aggression.
3. All dogs must be registered with the AAC and have a valid ID number in order to compete in this trial. Forms are available at <http://www.aac.ca/>.
4. There will be no refund of entries withdrawn after start time or in the event the dog or handler is dismissed from competition.
5. PLEASE DO NOT LITTER AND PLEASE USE DESIGNATED AREAS FOR YOUR DOGS AND THEN POOP AND SCOOP.
6. No familiarization will be offered.
7. Confirmation letters will be emailed. It is the competitor's responsibility to report any errors or omissions right away. Please ensure that you verify your entries as soon as you receive your confirmation.
8. Dogs that qualify on day one can advance to the next level on day two only.
9. Ribbons will be awarded throughout the day.
10. Field surface grassed and fenced.

TITLING CLASSES: Starters is for dogs that have not obtained the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. Advanced is for dogs that have obtained an ADC. Masters is for dogs that have obtained the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. Specials is open to all dogs. However, once a dog competes in a Specials titling class, it may no longer compete in any other agility class than Veterans. Veterans is for dogs whose age is 7 years for dogs currently competing in regular agility or 5 years for dogs that have competed in Specials for one calendar year. A dog may no longer compete in any other agility class than Veterans once entered in an official trial in any Veterans class.
